We want to ensure that new teachers are supported to get the very best start possible in their careers and have the tools in place to succeed and develop within the profession.

The Star Institute Partner Offer:

- > Facilitator training for up to two lead facilitators covering all eight pedagogical sessions.
- > Detailed learning and session materials including full facilitator notes.
- > The opportunity for mentors to attend our annual Mentor Conference.
- > The flexibility to tailor the learning to your own participants under an 80/20 rule.

The programme comprises:

- > A programme of eight sessions bringing together the Early Career Framework with the local context.
- > A diagnostic to support schools to ensure ECTs are accessing the training they need for their development.
- > A model for 'Afternoon tea' networking events which partners can choose to run as an additional benefit or at an additional cost
- > A conference for mentors to develop an understanding of the Early Career Framework and to strengthen mentoring skills.



The commitment for an ECT engaging with the programme will be six training sessions, from a choice of eight, lasting two hours and four networking events.
