## **RESPONSIBILITIES**

## 1. Individual providing group coaching on the NPQ leadership programmes

- 1 Provide coaching to an exceptional standard to assigned NPQ participants
- 1.1 Contract an effective coach/participant relationship at the start of the process, maintain during the arrangement and effectively conclude.
- 1.2 Demonstrate a range of listening and questioning skills, model and engage participants in dialogue and provide an appropriate balance of challenge.
- 1.3 Deliver coaching sessions and support, whether synchronous or asynchronous, to a high standard that supports participants.
- 1.4 Always being fully prepared for the session being delivered, arrive promptly, managing the time and ensuring a high quality learning experience for all participants
- 1.5 Ensure coaching is responsive to the participant, show empathy and encourage reflection, maintain confidentiality.
- 1.6 Be open to receive feedback and give appropriate feedback including strengths and development needs.
